WINNERS' ENCLOSURE

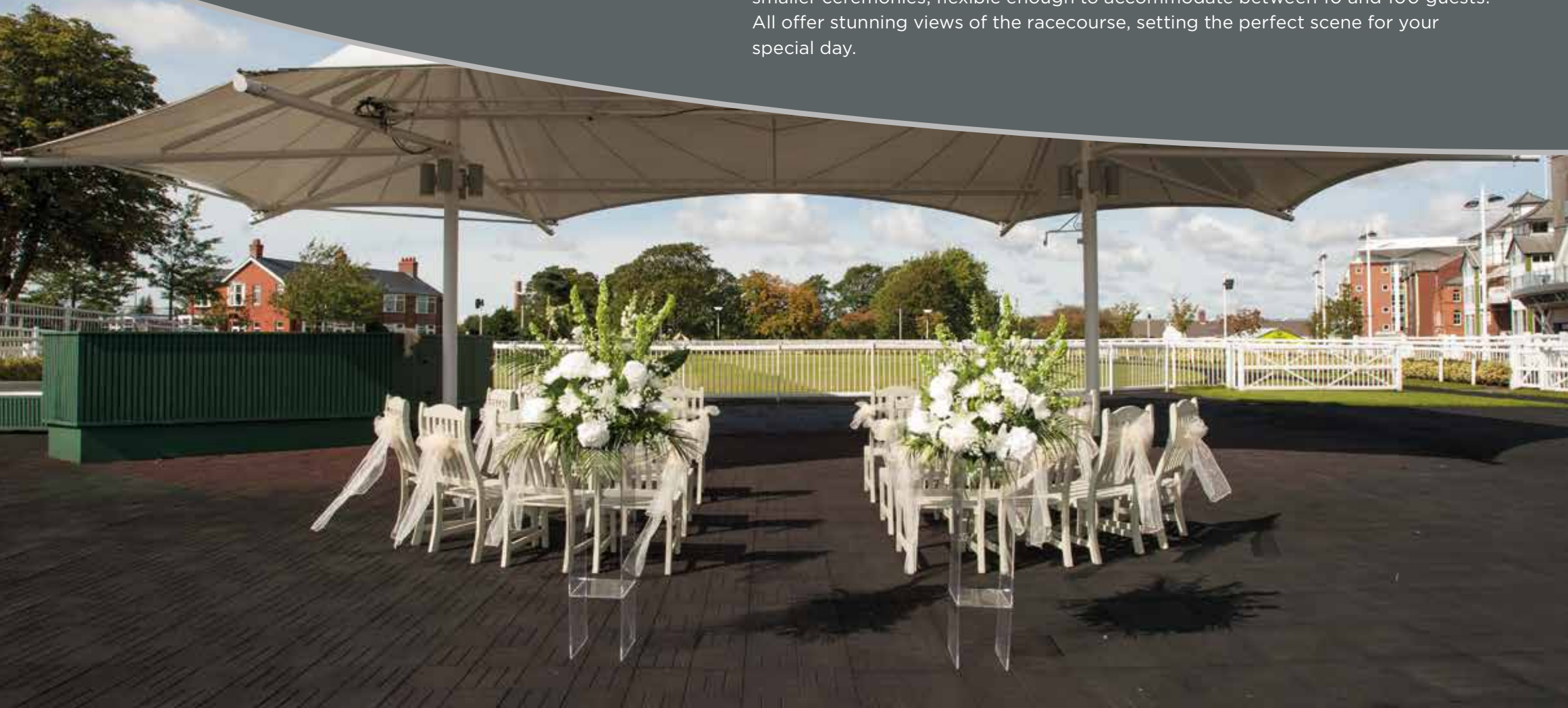

With a choice of exquisite suites accommodating up to 250 guests and magnificent racecourse views, the recently refurbished Princess Royal Suite offers a self-contained wedding venue together with the Merryman Suite or Princess Royal Suite which can accommodate up to 100 for your civil ceremony or partnership.



QUEEN MOTHER STAND

THINGS TO REMEMBER

12 MONTHS TO GO

- Determine the style and theme of your wedding and agree budget
- Decide on a wedding date and start searching wedding venues
- Apply for the necessary licenses and book in with registrar

9 TO 11 MONTHS

- Begin your search for bridal gown, shoes, accessories and lingerie, suit hire, photographer, entertainment, florist, transport, hair & beauty stylist, bridesmaid dresses, wedding cake and venue decoration
- Compile a preliminary guest list
- Choose your attendants and ensure they are aware of what their duties are
- Choose and purchase your wedding rings

6 TO 8 MONTHS

- Start planning ceremony and reception music choices
- Start looking at invitation designs
- Sign up for your gift registry/honeymoon donation scheme

4 TO 5 MONTHS

- Contact your florist and finalise your arrangements
- Order wedding stationery
- Book your wedding transport
- Arrange accommodation
- Choose your wedding cake
- Decide on your wedding decorations including favours

3 MONTHS

- Finalise your guest list
- Meet with registrar/officiant to discuss details of the ceremony
- Choose gifts for your attendants and parents
- Arrange suit fittings
- Confirm honeymoon arrangements

2 MONTHS

- Send out your invitations
- Schedule a hair and makeup trial
- Start making/buying wedding favours
- Finalise music selections for the ceremony and reception
- If changing your name, complete the proper documents

1 MONTH

- Meet with your photographer and provide a list of required shots
- Start working on your seating plan
- Confirm honeymoon reservations
- Arrange for a final wedding dress fitting

2 WEEKS

- Finalise seating chart
- Confirm delivery time and locations with florist
- Contact any guests you have not received an acceptance from

1 WEEK

- Collect wedding gown, bridesmaid, flower girl dresses and accessories
- Give final guest numbers to venue/receptions/caterer
- Make sure the men have their final suit fitting
- Reconfirm everything with vendors one last time

1 DAY BEFORE

- Attend rehearsal (if you are having one)
- Have a manicure/pedicure
- Confirm wedding day transportation
- Confirm all duties required with the wedding party
- Try to get an early night and relax!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Giving notice means declaring that you and your partner are both free to marry each other and will require you to provide certain documents. You may do this up to one year before the date of your wedding. You will need to make an appointment to give notice with the Register Office in the district in which you live. You are both required to give notice.

To give a marriage notice you and your partner must have lived in England or Wales for seven clear days immediately before you give notice.

After giving notice you must allow at least fifteen clear days before you can marry. Your marriage must then take place within twelve months of the date you gave notice.

The Registrar will tell you when your authority to marry is due to be issued.

If you are marrying in a district different to the one in which you live, you will need to take the certificate to that district before the day of the wedding.

HOW TO FIND US

Aintree Racecourse is located on the A59, just one mile from the M57 and M58, which link the M62 and M6. Follow the A59 to Liverpool and the brown tourist information signs for Aintree Racecourse as you approach the racecourse for routes to the car park.

BY RAIL

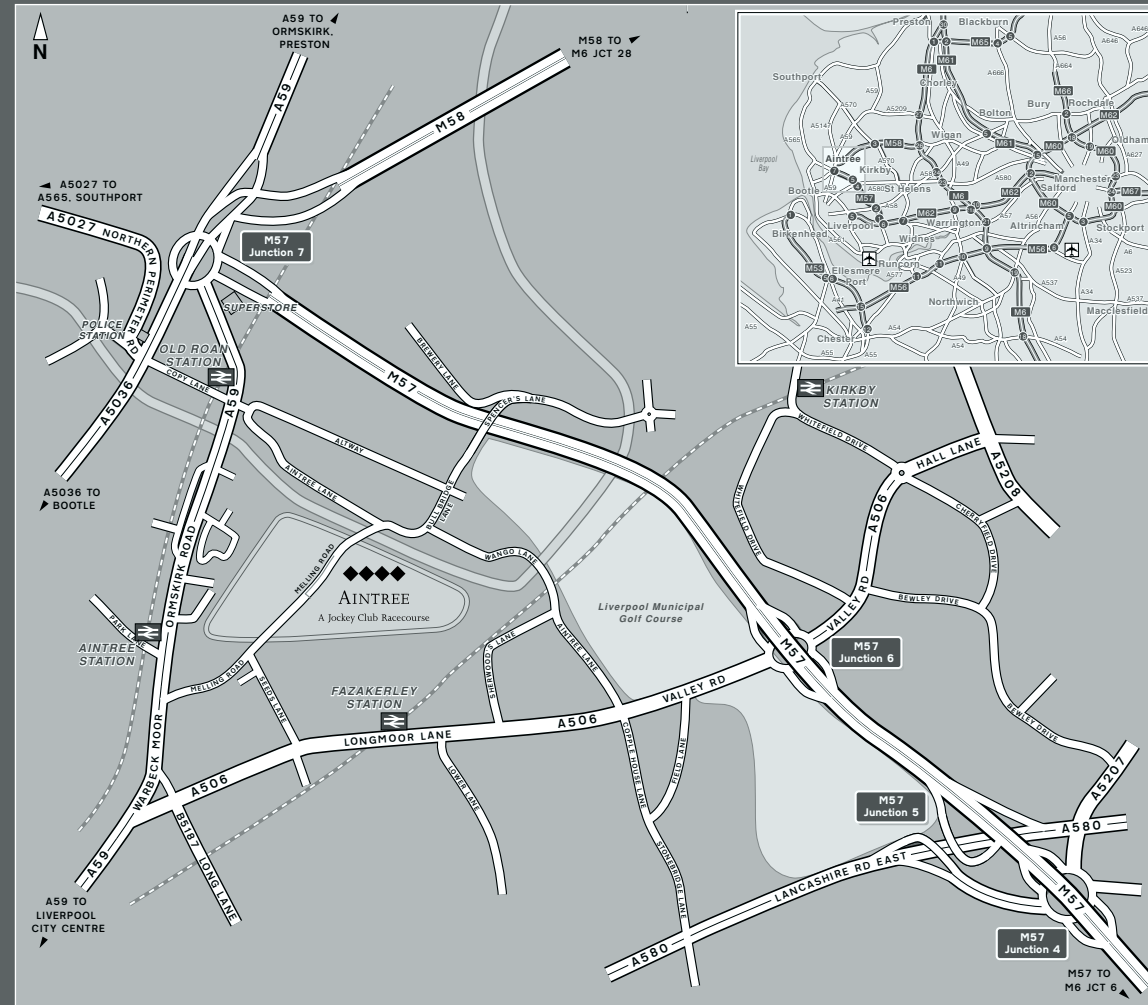
The nearest mainline station to Aintree is Liverpool Lime Street. Liverpool Central Station is just a short walk from Lime Street, where you can catch a train to Aintree. Aintree Station is directly opposite the racecourse, where trains run every 15 minutes during the day.

BY ROAD

From the South Leave M6 at J21A and join M62 west. Leave M62 at J6 to join M57, follow the brown tourist information signs for Aintree Racecourse.

From the North Leave M6 at J26 and join M58, follow the brown tourist information signs for Aintree Racecourse.

From Mersey Tunnels Follow signs for Preston, then for A59, follow the brown tourist information signs for Aintree Racecourse.
